Captain's Blog

Positive feedback indicates that the “Blog” works well so I will continue to use it to pass on relevant Committee decisions as well as a means of education and etiquette regarding the rules of golf.

First off - I don't know how many of you were observant enough to notice the syllabus change on the web site, but through popular demand the 4BBB round (actually pairs) usually held in August has been changed to an Ambrose 4 Ball format, the same format that we recently played at Churchill Park. As this is the same round that the Captain's Trophy final is played, the Captain's Trophy finalists will be first off as a pair, Club Captain (or responsible appointed referee) will be in the next group should a decision / ruling be required.

Secondly, LATE CANCELLATIONS / NO SHOWS :

These are costing the Club money as we have to pay upfront usually at least 1 week in advance and do not get refunds.

Therefore, following last night's Committee decision, a minimum one and a half weeks “CANCELLATION DEADLINE” from all members will now be enforced to avoid you having to pay green fees for a round that you did not play. This WILL be deducted from your green fee deposit and WILL have to be ‘topped up’ the next time you attend.

“DEADLINE” is the Wednesday a week and a half before an outing, giving the Treasurer time to pay the course.

NO EXCEPTIONS, RECORDS ARE BEING KEPT.

(You can still cancel out the day before an outing but you will have to pay the green fees)

Lastly, in relation to last month's blog about dress regulations.

- ‘Denim’ is not a colour, it is a type of material and black jeans are still ‘denim’.
- ‘Tee shirts’ are definitely not allowed.

We have just received from Settler's a copy of their dress regulations.

To avoid embarrassment to you and our Club please read and adhere to them.
