Hi Guys,

Just some feedback from our latest Committee meeting that is relevant to everyone.

- Score cards:** complaints have been tabled from our kind and soft hearted Handicapper that there are too many cards handed in that are, to put it bluntly, *disgustingly untidy, illegible, unreadable, indecipherable, a total mess, a junior school kid could have done better!, and quite honestly TOTALLY UNACCEPABLE*.
From now on he will be assisted in the perusal of your card when you hand it in, if it falls in the above category, it will be rejected and handed back to you to be re-written.
No arguments, if your card is illegible and you refuse to re-write it, it will be deemed as '*card not returned*' and you will be handicapped as 'No Score - Not Approved'.
See page 32 item 12 of the attached Australian Handicap System for the consequences.
Remember the onus is on the player to provide on his card: Name, date, handicap played off, Golfink number, score for each hole, signature and markers signature. (ALL LEGIBLE !!)
And to assist the handicapper we request you do the maths and provide the result.
- Sandhurst 16/08/2015:**
 - a) With format of our next outing in mind - team "Irish 4Ball -Stableford".
I know I've already sent out to you all the format and method of scoring but there is a possibility that we have an odd number on the day.
It is a fun day and the intension is for it to be fair to everyone.
Similar to when we play Ambrose, it is a disadvantage to be in a group of 3.
Therefore similar to our NSGC rules for compensating a 3-man Ambrose team we have in place a plan to compensate a 3-man "Irish 4Ball" team.
Note: using the 3-man team card example, and using only 3 scores (A,B+C) and adding best 2 the team would have ended up with 36 points.
But compensating them by adding a 'phantom 'X' score to the card, which is one third of the sum of all three scores per hole.
Then rounding up the final total to the next full point, the score is the same as if they had had a fourth team member.
Copies will be available on the day.
 - b) Fancy Dress. Please remember that your costume must still comply with Sandhurst's Dress regulations. (ie standard golf dress regulations : see attached guideline.)
NB: there will be a prize for the player adjudged 'Best Costume' so get involved.
I would bring a spare compliant set of golf clothes just in case your 'fancy dress' is deemed unacceptable. At least you can change and still play.
